Community self help for families of Special Needs Children

ABLE-differently is a third generation ABLE offspring from Children with Special Health Care Needs of the Utah State Health Department, continuing its vision in a different way to innovate and broker further family resources as a non-profit community program.

As differently-abled, it values diversity and holds high respect for families regardless of culture and ethnic life-ways. It supports parent involvement in solving problems in a self-help model. It serves young preschool and schoolage children in different ways, including re-



source support, problem solving, solution finding, and in building partnerships where a caring

group can offer multiple views, and search for solutions when it

was not known what to do for certain children who have not had success with typical forms of intervention. The family inspired team's motto is "Working together, we can do anything."

- The vision of the program is building positive and integrated, mental health scaffolding offering social, emotional and behavioral consultation among neighborhood schools, medical homes and other natural community environments, all working together.
- Then by using the quality and purposeful experiences
 the child has already lived through stories, a sense of
 agency and responsibility will then be built in the
 child enacting even new stories.

Enriched Storytelling Activity

A child's recreation or talent building experience has many components:

- Leisured and connected supervision with another caring adult away from the child's home.
- Such skill acquisition as learning to understand the rules of interaction and friendship building.
- Healthy benefits to the body and brain.

Through the website is promoted expressive and creative storytelling, drawing or writing, movement, music, and drama. Around this re-creative flow experience, it expands and enriches with a caring adult or peer relationship to develop new learning and further developmental levels in the child's brain and mind.

- Learning to cope with stress by recalling and reframing memorable stories from child-family.
- Expanding a positive self identity and claiming a stronger voice with such new thoughts as "I can do this, or I am a goal maker."
- With healthy attachment, your child, using his curiosity, will venture out to explore with a caring relationship working toward mastery over a new skill. He can then return home to tell his story.

For example, a coach or teacher takes a photo or offers a written anecdote with a storyline already formed which in turn is taken home and further co-developed by the child and parent and can then be entered into a scrapbook to highlight the memory of the experience to be enjoyed indefinitely.

FORMING OPTIMAL EXPERIENCES USING NATURAL ENVIRONMENTS

If interested in these ideas, talk to your child about his/her dreams of what she or he may want to do. Look at the website, visit nearby facilities near you and sense if there is a match between your child and the program offerings, know and feel its trust and comfort and query whether the teacher-

coach can join and take an increased interest in doing a little more for your child in beginning the narrative process. Is this where you want your



child to be? Review costs and demands on your time and consider options to meet these requirements. Who from the community, extended family, place of worship, friends can contribute? Ask about a sliding fee schedule or scholarship availability?
